THE ENVIROVET FACILITATOR E-COURSE **IN PROGRESS**

The partners are currently working on finalizing the EnviroVET Facilitator eCourse, which will be a 30-hour e-course composed of 5 topics on green approach. This output will target professionals working in the VET sector, equipping them with the relevant skills and knowledge to become advocates of sustainability. In addition, this course will be available in the different languages of the consortium in a free and accessible way.

To this end, the consortium is creating the relevant modules for the eCourse, reflecting all the knowledge they have acquired during the implementation of the project and combining initiatives and learning strategies from their specific countries.

The course will eventually consist of the following topics:

- 1. General Policies
- 2. Infrastructure and Facilities
- 3. Vocational Education and Training
- 4. Teaching and Training Methodologies
- 5. Staff Continuous Training and Personal Development

Next steps:

In the coming months, a piloting session will be conducted in which students, teachers and VET centers will test the materials created as part of the Facilitator e-Course. This will allow us to make the relevant improvements and finalize the result, which will be available on the project platform in the different languages of the consortium.

Moreover, since we are in the final stage of the project and its end is approaching, the partners will soon hold the local Multiplier Events, where they will disseminate the project and its results. At these events, the consortium will promote the different outputs of the project, boosting the impact of the results and reaching more individuals of the target audience.

Finally, the partners are preparing for the last EnviroVET Transnational Project Meeting, which will take place on November 7 in Vilnius (Lithuania).
