## Promoting and Tracking Environmental Sustainability in VET

The project aims to support the **professional development** of vocational education practitioners environmental awareness by tracking and quantifying the environmental impact of the sector.

### Our goals:

- Increase recognition of green skills among **75 vocational education practitioners**.
- Increase uptake and adoption of green skills among **200 vocational training learners**.
- Implementation of environmental and sustainability best practices among **30 vocational education and training organisations**.
- Establishment of an active, focused network for staff and organisations to exchange resources, knowledge and best practices.

## THE ENVIROVET BEST PRACTICE TOOLKIT, ENVIRONMENTAL CHARTER, AND ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT MEASUREMENT TOOLS ARE ALREADY BEING USED!

The project's **Best Practice Toolkit**, comprising a useful and relatable collection of best practices, case studies and success stories of existing VET sector greening practices at institutional level, and **Environmental Charter**, setting out the minimum requirements that VET institutions need to meet to consider themselves sufficiently sustainable, are now available in the project platform.

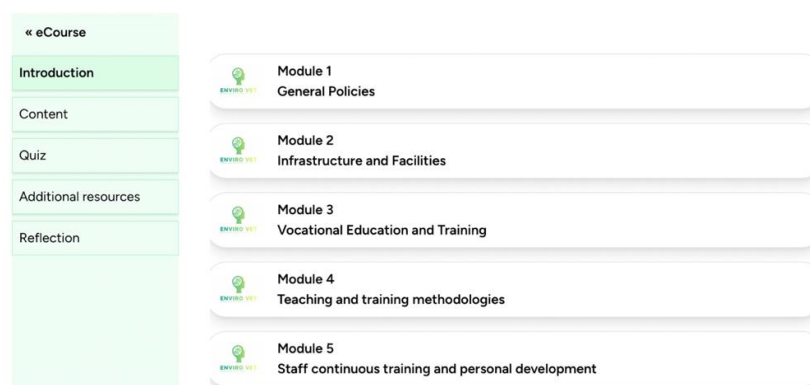
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Moreover, a highly innovative, online, digital **Environmental Impact Measurement Tool** providing an evaluation method and tool that evaluates the carbon footprint of a VET centre, based on the criteria set out in the **Environmental Charter** and an **e-Course** for VET practitioners to learn how to facilitate a green approach and the implications, benefits, and potential application areas in the VET sector are now finetuned and ready to be used.

## ENVIROVET e-COURSE READY TO BE UTILIZED!

The EnviroVET Facilitator eCourse is a 30-hour e-course on green approach that targets professionals working in the VET sector. The five modules of this online course- with blended learning and micro, interactive learning features-, will equip those professionals working in the VET sector with relevant skills and knowledge.

In addition, this course will be available in the different languages of the consortium in a free and accessible way. To this end, the consortium is creating the relevant modules for the eCourse, reflecting all the knowledge they have acquired during the implementation of the project and combining initiatives and learning strategies from their specific countries.
