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PROJECT STATUS

The EnviroVET project is at the halfway point and now the partners are looking forward to piloting the project results with vocational training centres to gather valuable end user feedback and improve the results.

The project consortium is preparing and coordinating the planned piloting activities for the Best Practice Toolkit, Environmental Charter and the Impact Measurement Tool which will take place from January to March 2023.

To date, the project has engaged with key stakeholders from vocational training centres through consultations held to gather input on the final project results. This includes:

- 35 VET practitioners provided feedback to develop the Best Practice Toolkit
- 7 policy makers and 35 VET providers involved in developing the Environmental Charter
- 30 key stakeholders engaged with through two consultation meetings





RESULTS UPDATE

The final version of the **EnviroVET Best Practice Toolkit** contains a compilation of **best practices**, **case studies** and **success stories** from across European vocational education and training, relating to the implementation of environmental best practices. These were used to inform the **EnviroVET Environmental Charter** - which provides a comprehensive list of actions VET centres can implement to achieve a minimum level of environmentally focused requirements that VET institutions need to meet in order to consider themselves to be environmentally "compliant".

The consortium are continuing work on the **EnviroVET Environmental Impact Measurement Tool,** an online evaluation tool based on the SELFIE selfassessment tool which will allow users to compare and exchange best practices
on environmentally friendly approaches to vocational education and training.
